

## **Waukesha Farmers' Market Guidelines during COVID-19**

**\*\*\*These are subject to change when new information is shared with the management team.\*\*\***

**The Waukesha Farmers' Market has decided to adopt these guidelines for the health and safety of our patrons and vendors until further notice:**

- 1. People will travel in a clockwise direction throughout the market and arrows will be marked on the ground to serve as a reminder.**
- 2. No sampling of products will be allowed unless they are placed in individual containers (no platters) or distributed on an individual basis (poured into a small cup).**
- 3. Vendor set-up may be modified to allow more space between selling areas when available.**
- 4. Booth spaces may be modified to increase the space between vendors and customers.**
- 5. Social distancing will be practiced throughout the market.**
- 6. All prepared foods will be pre-packaged for takeout consumption.**
- 7. Vendors will handle products until given to the customer.**
- 8. All vendors will have hand sanitizer at their booths.**
- 9. Customers are encouraged to bring their own individual hand sanitizer as well.**
- 10. Parents are advised to closely supervise children while in the market. Children should always be kept within an arm's length of their parents .**
- 11. If you are running a fever, coughing, or generally not feeling well, please stay home.**
- 12. We are encouraging everyone to use common sense and act responsibly when attending the market.**
- 13. 2 Porta Potties are available. One toilet will be designated for vendors & handicapped customers only at this time. This will provide greater safety by separating vendor use from that of the general public.**
- 14. There will be signs to remind the public to practice social-distancing**

### **Vendor Information**

- 1. If you are not feeling well, please stay home. Contact the market's management: 262-309-3607 (Norm), 262-271-7448 (Jeff), 630-776-6889 (Chris) to let us know you won't be coming.**
- 2. We encourage you to have one person handling all money transactions.**
- 3. Use individual bags for each type of product when possible.**
- 4. Clean and disinfect tables and surfaces, including tablecloths, when setting up and as needed.**
- 5. Use single use gloves when they are warranted.**
- 6. Avoid touching hands to the face, nose, or eyes.**
- 7. Please advise customers of correct cleaning procedure for any products purchased.**
- 8. Vendors that have any concerns about coming to the market should contact the market management team**

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
